Deposits and cancellations

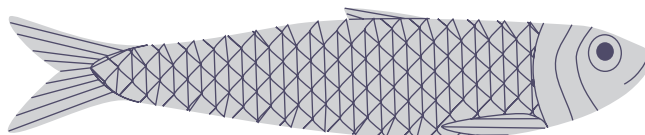
A deposit of 30 % of the tour price is required upon booking to confirm participation.

The balance of the tour price is required to be paid 21 days prior to the tour departure date. Cancellations must be received more than 15 days prior to departure for a 100% refund. A 50% refund is given in the case of a cancellation made between 7 to 15 days prior to departure. The tour price will be forfeited if cancellations are made less than 7 days prior to departure.

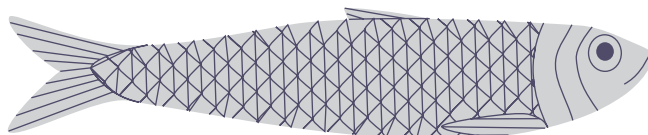

Equipment and Clothing

Lifejacket Adventures will provide all camping equipment if required on the tour.

For the Vis and Hvar Islands Kayak Adventure or the Korcula to Dubrovnik Kayak Adventure it is advised to pack everything into one large expedition-style dry-bag, such as those manufactured by The North Face. Lifejacket Adventures will provide dry-bags for day-to-day use.

Generally the weather during the season is warm, but in the morning and evenings it may be a little cool, and there is always the chance of rain. For these reasons guests will need to provide themselves with both sun-protection as well as a warm layer. We do not expect very cold weather, but a useful idea when outdoors is to leave cotton garments at home, i.e. clothes should be of unnatural materials (fleece, Capilene, etc).

Comfortable, durable footwear is crucial on our outdoor vacation as blisters and cuts will ruin the fun. Sneakers or sandals (such as Tevas) are good to wear in the kayak because of Dalmatia's rocky coast. But remember they will get wet so do not bring your brand new expensive pair. For those hiking, light boots are ample as the trails are well maintained.

For the evenings, guests should be dressed to sit in seaside cafes and bars, digesting the seafood from the local restaurants. The temperatures will be around 25 Celsius. Mosquitoes can be friendly at the wineries in the evening, so long, light clothing is recommended.
